Important Information

- * EdCamp is a program concentrated into five days. Any absence from instruction or rehearsal is detrimental to the group and individual success of the EdCamp experience for the participant as well as the other participants. For this reason, we ask that parents not schedule appointments for participants and that participants not make plans (e.g. concerts) that conflict with the EdCamp schedule.
- * The teacher recommendation (for first year participants) is a confidential communication between the teacher and the Camp Director. For that reason it should be sent by the teacher directly to the Camp Director.
- * Punctuality is essential. Each participant should arrive each day by 8:00 a.m.
- * For the final performance, black t-shirts will be provided by EdCamp. Participants are required to wear black shoes, black socks or black hose, and black trousers (not shorts, capris, skirts, etc.).
- * Participants should consider their summer schedules before registering to avoid it being necessary to cancel. Supplies are ordered weeks before EdCamp begins. If circumstances make a participant unable to attend EdCamp, no refunds can be issued for cancellations after June 29.

What is Theatre Camp?

It's an opportunity for middle and high school students (at least 10 years old and in 5th through 12th grade in the 2016-2017 school year) to attend a week-long camp with workshops and clinics led by professional performers and teachers in the art of comedy, drama, and musical theatre.

Who was Ed Lonzinski?

He was a local guy who attended Blue Ridge School District and Mansfield College. He was involved in various community theatres, participating in all areas of production. While directing for Greene High School in New York, Ed realized the value of educating students in the art of theatre, and strived to make it possible for his students to participate in theatre festivals offered in more urban regions. It was the desire of Ed, who was to serve on the Board of Directors of EMTC, to offer students high-level experiences in the art. Through the generosity of his parents, Dolly and Mike, a fund was established to create a living memorial to this extremely committed and talented young man and EdCamp was born.

Preliminary Registration

When and where is EdCamp and how much does it cost?

The final performance (open to the public and free of any admission charge) will be on Friday July 21 at 7:00 p.m. in the Norman J Maza Auditorium of Mountain View High School.

How much does it cost? Tuition is \$95 per student.

Workshops/Classes

Students will attend at least four classes each day followed by a daily rehearsal period for the final performance. Class topics will vary including Dance, Improvisation, Vocal Techniques, Monologues, Character Development, Technical Theatre, Audition Preparation, or other areas of the art of theatre.

Preparation

For the first day of EdCamp 2017, participants must prepare two short monologues 1-2 minutes in length, one comic and one dramatic. Additional information will be included in the welcome letter which will be sent to all applicants. Participants who wish to audition a song should be prepared to do so on the first day of classes and should bring the piano accompaniment for that solo. **Karaoke versions or tracks are not acceptable.**
