NOTE: A letter of reference is **REOUIRED** for all first time applicants from a teacher. The letter must be either emailed to emtc.net from the reference or in a sealed envelop from the teacher providing the recommendation. The letter of recommendation must address the applicant's ability, behavior and integrity.

Prepare two short monologues, 1-2 minutes in length, one comic and one dramatic. Students who wish to audition with a song should be prepared to do so on the first day and bring piano music for that proposed solo. Additional information will be provided in the welcome letter.
